



YOUTH FISHING CLASS

Learn the basics of fishing! Each week participants learn a new aspect of fishing such as casting, safety, knots, equipment and more. Participants spend the first 30 minutes of each class learning about fish, where they live, and how to catch them. Then, adult volunteers help the kids use their new skills to catch fish. Adult supervision is required during classes. Class size is limited, please register early!

Ages: 6 to 13 (those 12 years old or older must have a license to fish in Utah)
